I hereby expressly release for myself and for my heirs, legal representatives, and assigns, and agree to save, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the City of West Palm Beach, Florida, its departments, officers, officials, employees, agents and legal representatives, from any and all claims, demands, suits, loss, cost or expense, actions, judgments, and against the City of West Palm Beach, Florida, its Departments, officers, officials, employees, agents, and legal representatives, by reason of any damage to property or personal injury, including death, sustained by myself or any person whatsoever, which arises out of or is incidental to or in any way connected to my participation in the Ride-Along Program, regardless of whether such claim, demand, suit, loss, cost, or expense, action, judgment, or execution is caused in whole or in part by any negligent act or omission of the City of West Palm Beach or its departments, officers, officials, employees, agents, and legal representatives.

I hereby understand that the dissemination of any information, written or verbal, I may see or hear during my participation in the Ride-Along program is a violation of **State and Federal laws**.

Rules and General Information:

1. Applicants must be a minimum of 18 years of age.
2. A minimum of 3 days advance notice prior to the requested ride-a-long date is required to allow for application processing and scheduling.
3. Participation is limited to four (4) hour sessions between the hours of 7 AM to 2 AM, seven days a week, except in special circumstances as specified in S.O.P. I-16.
4. Participation is limited to one ride-along per sixty days period, except in special circumstances as specified in S.O.P. I-16.
5. Applicants are required to sign a liability release and covenant not to sue agreement prior to the ride along.
6. The applicant must provide photo identification (i.e., driver's license or other acceptable I.D.).
7. A maximum of four citizen participants can be permitted to ride during a given four hour session.
8. Attire is casual, reflecting good taste and conservatism.
