## **Citizen Observer Patrol**

Citizens who are certified (through training) to assist officers in patrol activities and serve as additional eyes and ears.

## **Community Service Program**

A pre-trial intervention program directed at first time misdemeanor offenders which offers options for community service. Contact Phone No. 653-3578

## **Crime Watch**

Communities assist law enforcement in watching out for their neighbors and by reporting suspicious activity to the police.

## **DARE (Drug Abuse Resistance Education)**

Trained and certified Officers teach drug and gang education in schools and encourage resistance to drug use.

## **Graffiti Eradication Program**
